



Photography Excursions take you to the heart of one of the most rapidly disappearing wetlands in the world, Theriot, Louisiana. Coastal Louisiana loses about 18 square miles of wetlands a year due to natural and man-made causes; *impacting all living things*.

Photographers may choose locations including:

- Bayous

- Plants, wildlife, birds, and people
- Optional: A Photography Instructor may be available if requested

Excursions include: a two-night stay at Camp Dularge, half-day boat trip into the wetlands and introduction to local culture & cuisine.
