Student Excursions take you to the heart of one of the most rapidly disappearing wetlands in the world, Theriot, Louisiana. Coastal Louisiana loses about 18 square miles of wetlands a year due to natural and man-made causes; *impacting all living things.*

Students will learn:

- About different types of wetlands
- How to identify cause/affect of wetland loss
- Coastal restoration methods
- How to recognize non-native/invasive species
- Local culture and way of life

Excursions include: a two-night stay at Camp Dularge, half-day boat trip into the wetlands and introduction to local culture & cuisine.

Rates: 4 participants - \$500 per person / 5 participants - \$400 per person / 6 participants - \$335 per person (For less than 4 participants, the entire weekend flat fee is \$2,000)
