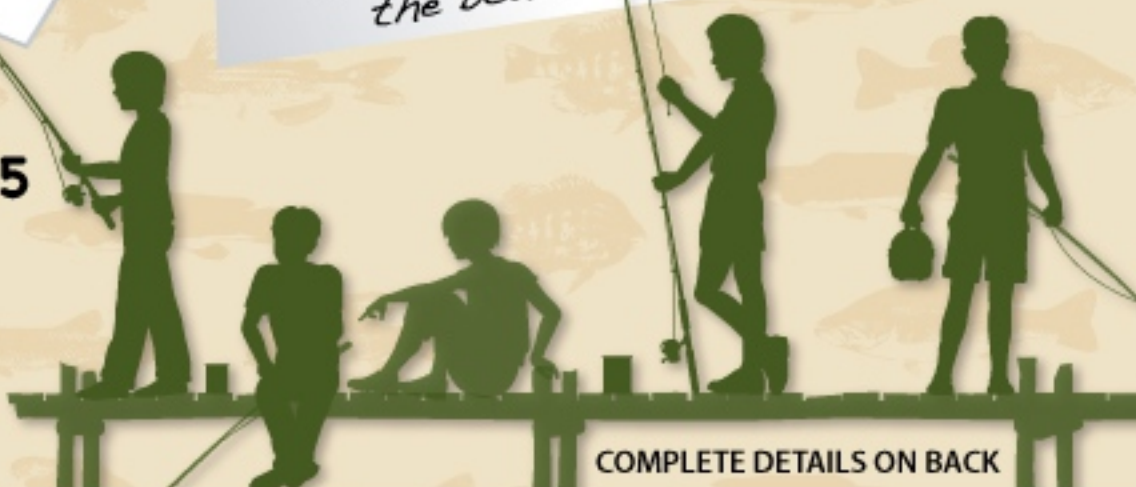

Awards: One boy and girl Louisiana Youth Angler of the Year will be selected. A plaque and a prize will be given during the Louisiana Outdoor Writers Association Banquet the second weekend in August. LOWA will pay the banquet fee for the student and two guests.
