Bird Watching Excursions take you to the heart of one of the most rapidly disappearing wetlands in the world, Theriot, Louisiana. Coastal Louisiana loses about 18 square miles of wetlands a year due to natural and man-made causes; *impacting all living things.*

Bird watchers will observe:

- How wetland loss negatively impacts habitat, resident and migratory bird species and populations
- Local & Wading birds
- Migratory Songbirds and Neotropical birds
- Birds of prey (eg. Bald Eagles, Osprey, Hawks)
- Brown and White Pelicans, seasonally
- Local Bird Guide available by request in migratory & mating seasons

Excursions include: a two-night stay at Camp Dularge, half-day boat trip into the wetlands and introduction to local culture & cuisine.

Rates: 4 participants - \$500 per person / 5 participants - \$400 per person / 6 participants - \$335 per person (For less than 4 participants, the entire weekend flat fee is \$2,000).
